The following students received prizes for the intra-college hackathon event (SPRINTZ'24), organized by the Hackathon Cell of SXCCE on 26.09.2024.

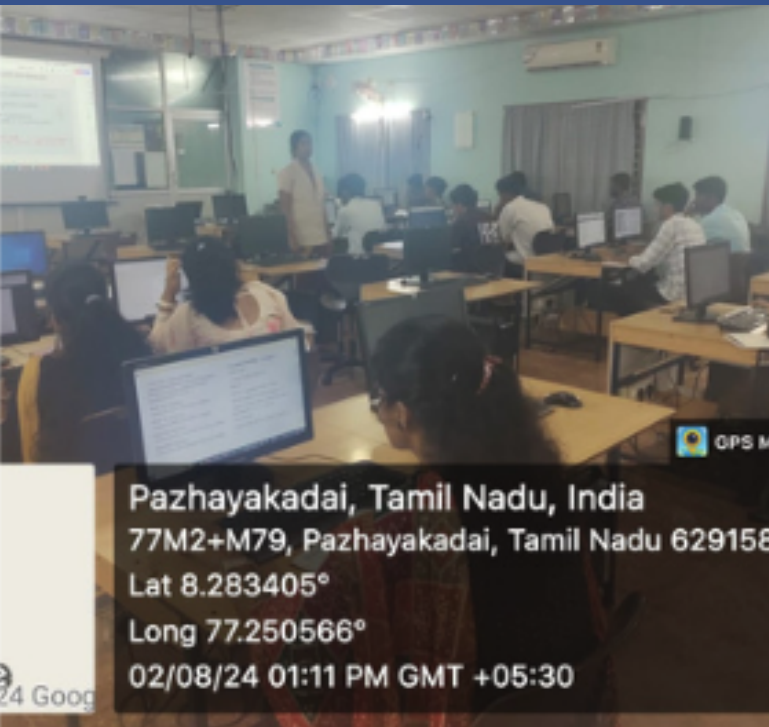
- A team of two students (ARNOLD T. DEOHERSHIN J.S.) from III CSE received a cash prize of Rs.2500.

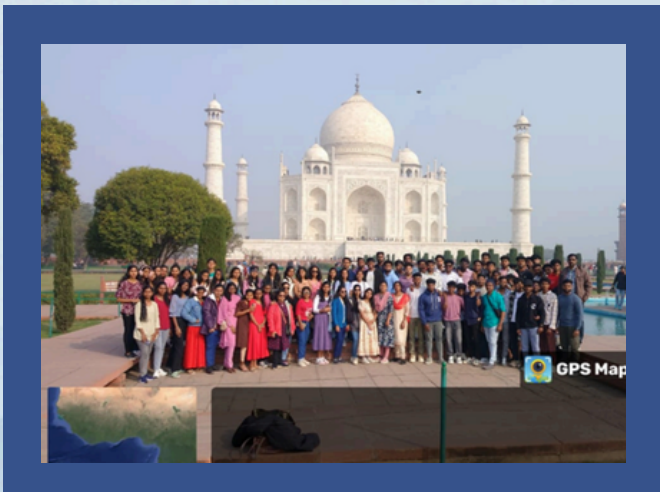
ACTIVITIES

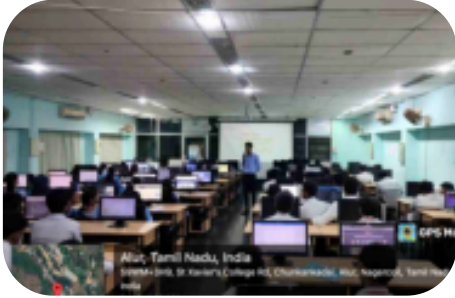
The session was highly engaging and offered valuable perspectives on the intersection of law and advocacy

SEMINAR

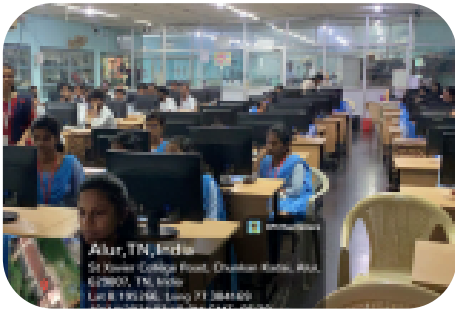
