

The training included programming on mathematical logics relevant to companies like TCS, Infosys, Wipro, and Zoho, aptitude questions from Infosys, Zoho, Wipro, and Capgemini, and soft skills development focusing on vocabulary building, reading comprehension, and sentence correction. This session also ended with a written assessment, benefiting 70 students.
- Kaar Technologies conducted an On & Pool Campus Placement Drive on 24th and 25th July 2025 for B.E/B.Tech students from CSE, IT, AI & DS, ECE, EEE, and MECH branches. The eligibility criteria required students to have secured 80% and above in 10th and 12th standards and 75% and above in their degree. The offered salary package ranged from ₹6.5 to 8.0 Lakhs per annum (CTC). A total of 12 students, including 10 from SXCCE and 2 from other institutions, were shortlisted for the final interview to be held at the company premises.

Blossoms special training

These sessions concluded with a written assessment and benefited 90 students.


Sri Sai Power Equipment's Pvt.Ltd
