- It is informed that willingness will be received soon from faculty members to act as the faculty advisor for professional, non-professional cells and service bodies.



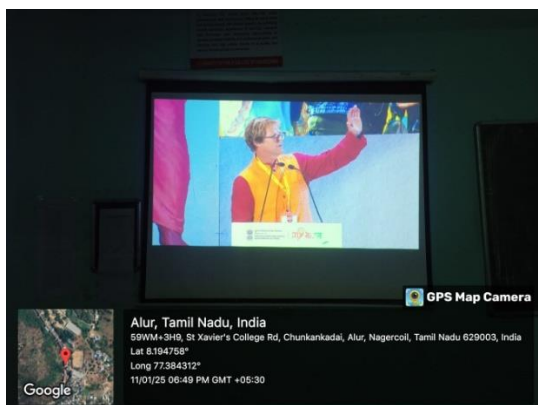
Trekking

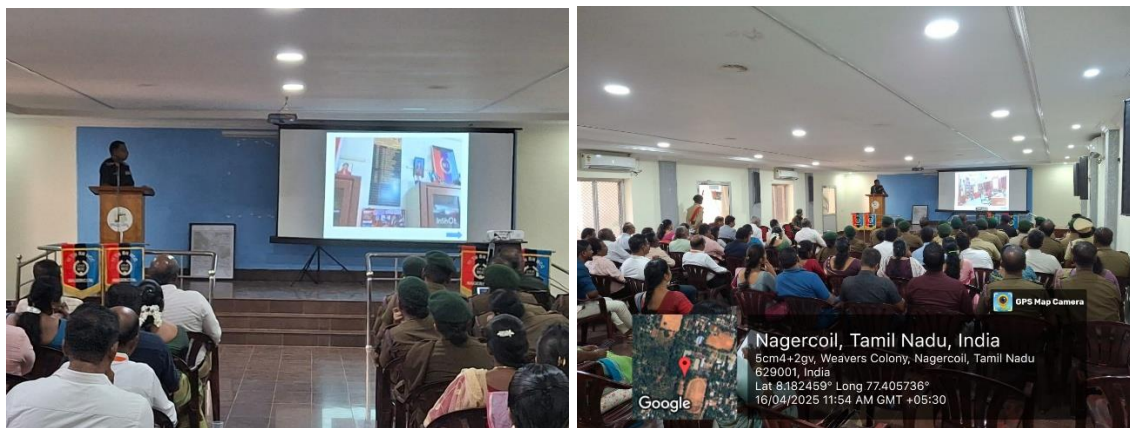
NCC Day celebration

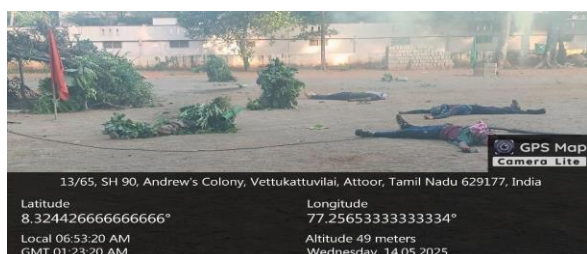
Interaction & Progress on NCC Activities - Seminar

Volunteers recorded scientific names, ecological benefits and promoting awareness of biodiversity and conservation.

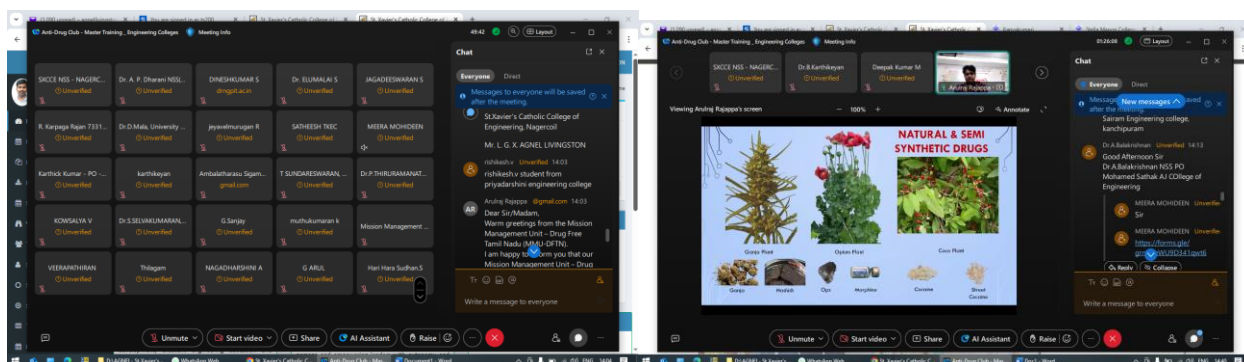

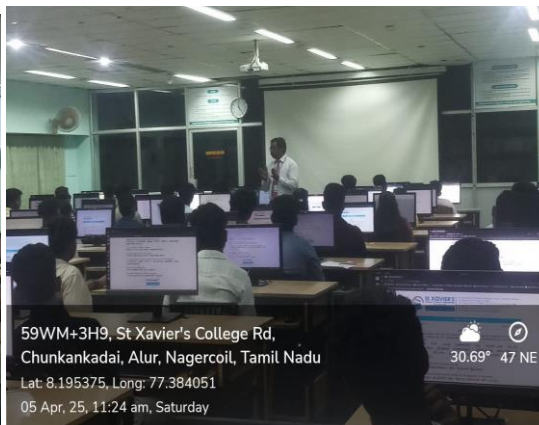


SXMSE (05/04/2024):

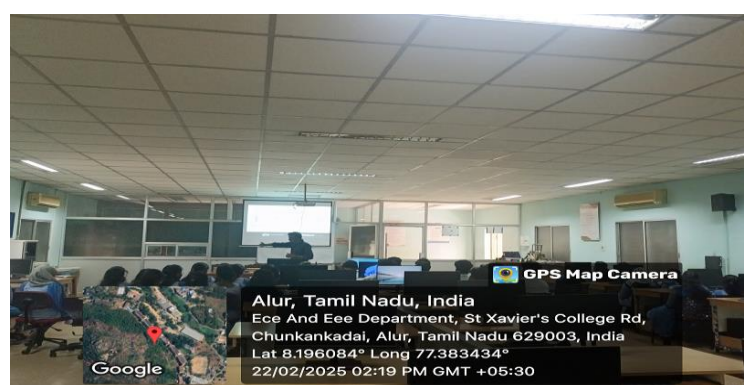


Institution's Innovation Council Report-II 2024-2025 Even

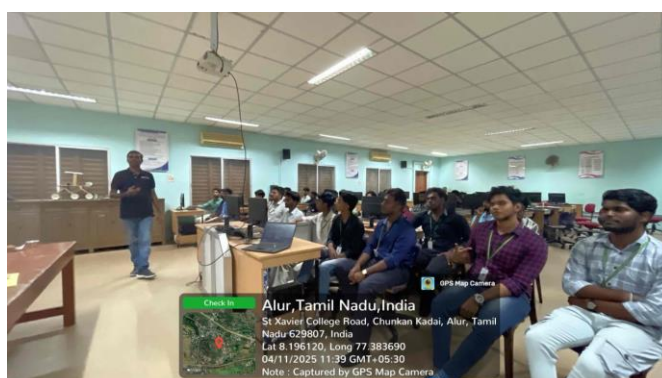
