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

- Implement interdisciplinary programmes fostering innovation and creativity.
- Lab experiments can be assessed through viva after each experiment.
- Lab programmes can be differentiated to enhance learning variety and engagement.
- The Course Outcomes are calculated with split-up marks for Internals.
- Split-up marks for the End Semester Examination should also be obtained.
- Currently, the pass percentage is being used for outcome measurement of the End Semester Examination, which is not

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accurate. Instead, the outcome for each individual student should be considered.

- The placement outcomes are not meeting expectations. This area needs to be thoroughly analyzed, and appropriate steps should be taken to improve the results.
- Importance shall be given for design based experiments.
- Industrial and multidisciplinary projects shall be encouraged.
- Integrate advanced technological tools into the teaching process to increase student engagement and improve learning outcomes.
- Explore partnerships with external academic institutions and industry leaders to expand research opportunities for faculty and students.
