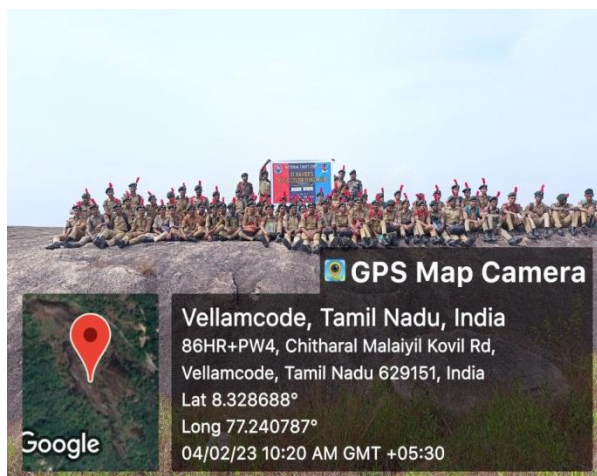
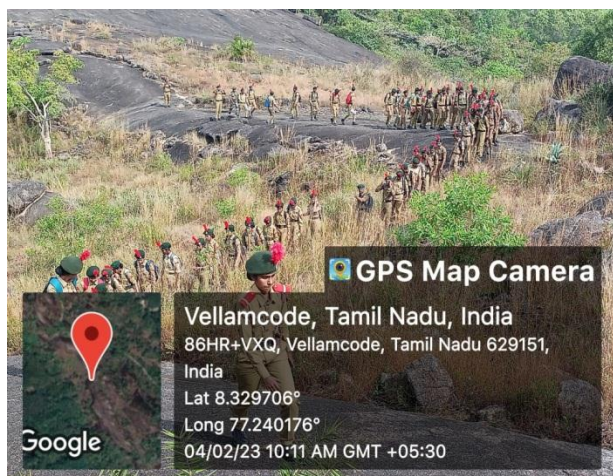


Annual Training Camp

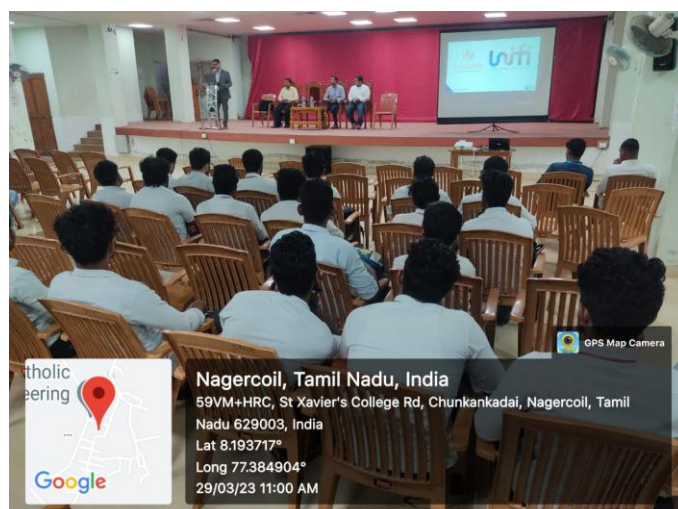

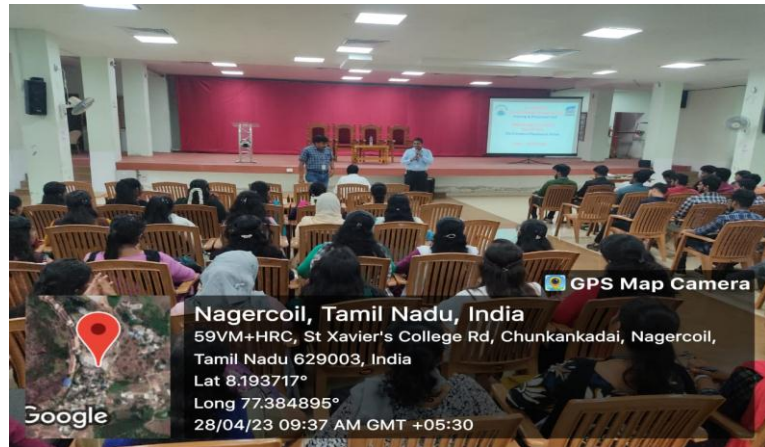

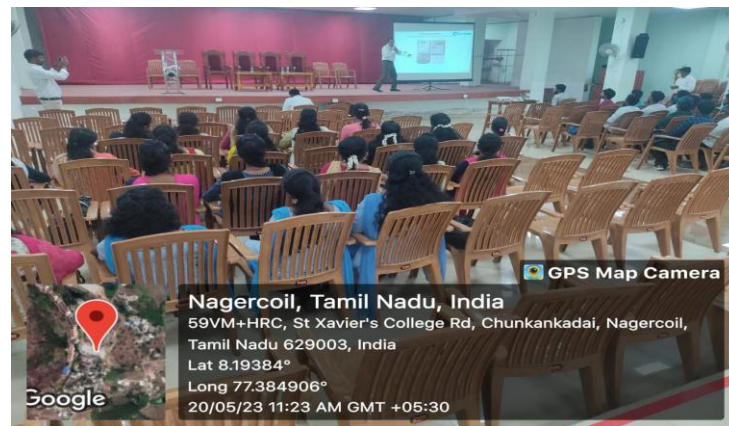
