NCC Report: 2023-2024 (June 2023 to November 2023)

National Cadet Corps aims at creating a pool of organized, trained and motivated youth with leadership qualities in all walks of life, who will serve the Nation regardless of which career they choose.

Camps

Annual Training Camps

Annual Training Camp was conducted at Scott Christian College, Nagercoil, from 11-07-2023 to 20-07-2023. The camp started on 11 July 23 with the total strength of 500 cadets which includes 90 SD cadets, 45 SW cadets, 243 JD cadets and 122 JW cadets. Eleven cadets including 3 SW cadets of our college participated in this camp. The Opening Address was delivered by Camp Comdt Col C P Unni Krishnan on 12 Jul 2023. Daily early morning Physical Training and Karata training were given to all cadets. Drill with and without weapon was conducted to all cadets. Weapon training classes were handled. Common and Special subjects were handled by ANO's and PI staff respectively. All the senior division and senior wing cadets got opportunity to fire using .22 rifle. Our cadet Anish D S got second prize in firing competition. Cadets exhibit their talents during the cultural program. Our ANO acted as the Camp Adjutant in this camp.





Annual Training Camp was conducted at Rohini College of Engineering & Technology, Anjugramam, from 22-08-2023 to 31-08-2023. From our college thirteen cadets

including 1 SW cadet participated in this camp. Motivation & awareness Special lectures were conducted for NCC cadets. Rallies on Drug awareness and Climate Change & Coastal Protection were also conducted. Cadet Abinesh M Raj got first prize in solo dance competition and our cadets also got first prize for group dance competition.





NCC unit 11 (TN) BN NCC Nagercoil conducted CATC CUM RDC TRG-I at NTA, Idayapatti, Madurai from 21 Oct 2023 to 30 Oct 2023. Total 500 cadets from all over Tamil Nadu participated in this camp. From our college thirteen cadets including 6 SW cadets and the ANO participated. Our ANO performed the duty of Camp Adjutant. Cadets were taken to Keeladi Heritage Museum on 26-10-2023. Keeladi excavations are archaeological excavations that have been taking place in the village of Keeladi, near Madurai. Some crucial findings such as beads, iron tools, terracotta figurines, expensive gold ornaments, flint earrings etc used by people lived during Sangam period, are placed in the museum. Demo on FC & BC using Bicat strips and smoke were also conducted. Madurai Group Commander Col Amit Gupta addressed the cadets on 27-10-2023. Our cadet Sivamohan V got second prize in firing competition. Our SD cadets and SW cadets are part of Volley ball and Throw ball winning teams.


5. INDEPENDENCE DAY (15.08.2023)


6. INAUGURATION OF NON-PROFESSIONAL CELLS (24-09-2022)


