Camps attended

Annual Training Camps

L/Cpl Tony Mathew attended CATC CUM DTE RDC Launch - I camp from 8-12-2023 to 17-12-2023 at NTA Idayapatti. Closing Address was delivered by Camp Comdt Lt Col L S Bhandari on 17-12-2023. Prizes were given to the deserved cadets. Our cadet L/Cpl Tony Mathew got first prize in English Elocution competition. He is also a member of 11 (TN) BN contingent which won first prize in drill competition.

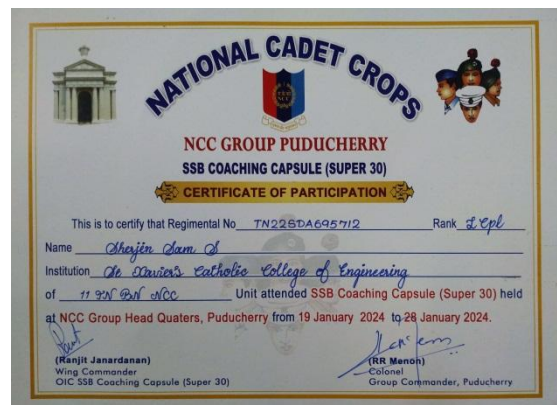
Advanced Leadership Camp

SSB Capsule (Super 30)

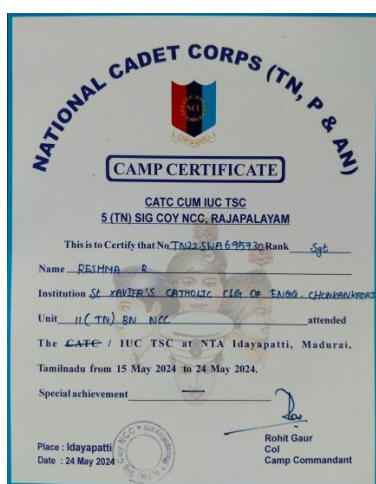

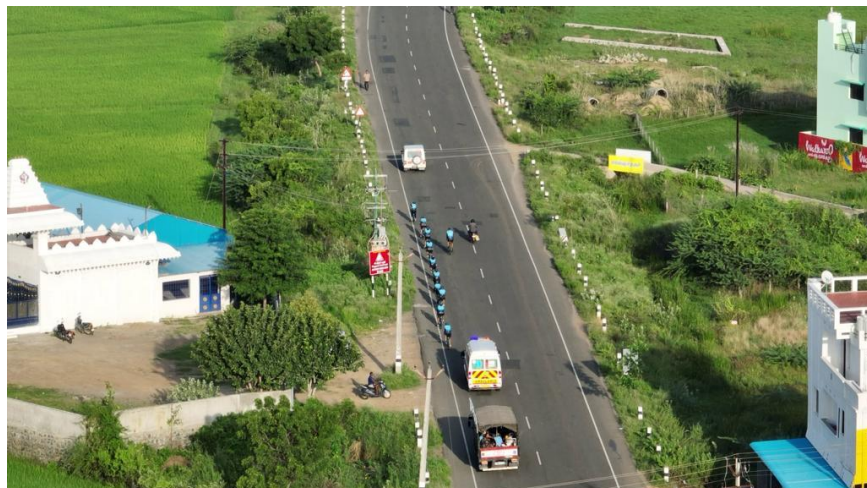
Performance audit

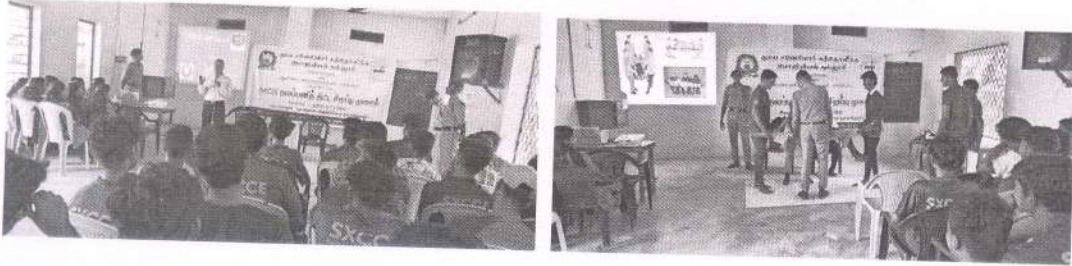


Cyclathon

for the problem statements.

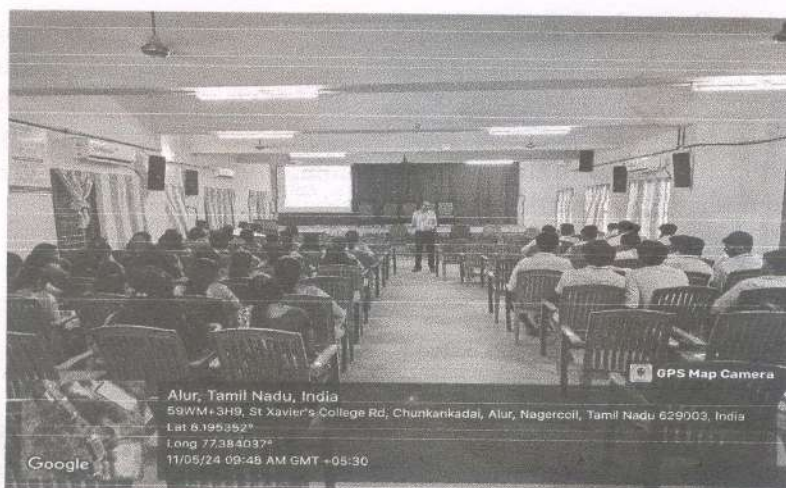
