Guidance for competitive examinations and career counselling offered by the Institution


Orientation program Higher Studies Abroad


Interactive session on employability skills


Awareness program on Career Options


Seminar on How to Crack GATE Exam


Soft Skills Training - 4 days


TCS Company Specific Training - 10 days
