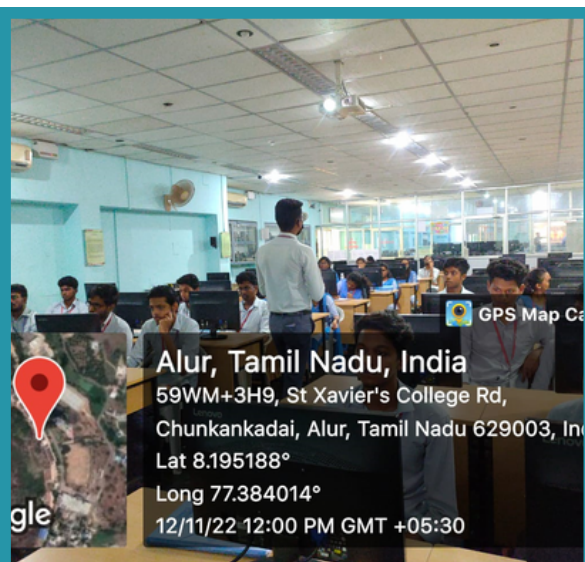

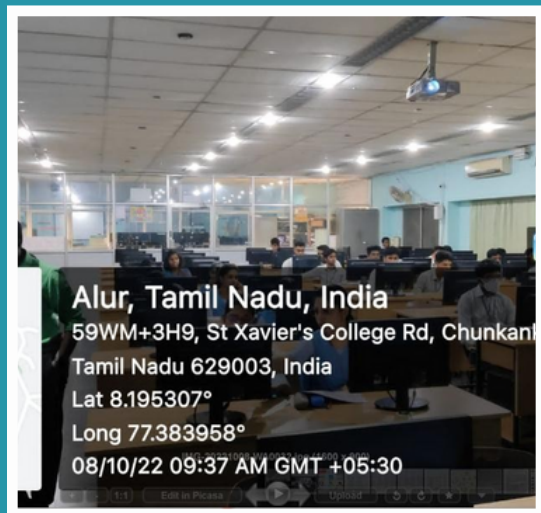


## WORKSHOP

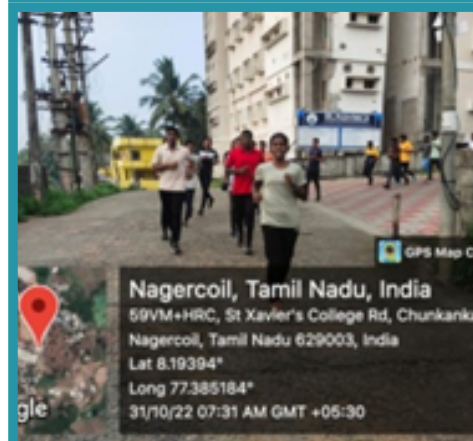
## PTA MEETING
